PILOT/NAVIGATOR SELECTION BOARD REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

- Cover Letter (One page)
- Resume (One page)
- Official College Transcripts showing Bachelor's Degree earned
 - For final semester graduates interviewing during your final semester, you must submit a letter from your Dean stating that you will graduate at the end of the semester based on current course load along with transcripts.
- Three Letters of Recommendation
 - Military members must have CC and NCOIC letters
- Copy of all Enlisted Performance Reports and/or Officer Performance Reports for current or former military members
- Air Force Officers Qualifying Test Scores (AFOQT)
 - Pilot Candidate Scores (2015 AFRC averages)
 - Pilot- 87
 - Navigator- 71
 - Verbal- 61
 - Quantitative- 55
 - Navigator Candidate Minimum Scores
 - Pilot- 10
 - Navigator- 25
 - Verbal- 15
 - Quantitative- 10
- Pilot Candidate Selection Method Scores
 - Pilot Candidates Only
 - 78 was the average score in 2015
- Private Pilots Certificate
 - Required only for pilot candidates
- FAA Third Class Medical
- Civilian candidates must be less than 30 years old when entering UPT/UNT. Pilots must have 20/70 or better unaided eyesight, and navigators must have 20/200 or better unaided.
- Inform the unit of any prior arrests. Include any applicable court documents. This is not a job disqualifier.

Interview boards are held twice a year, in the fall and in the spring, to select candidates for the Air Force Reserve Command Board. Applicants will not be interviewed if any of the above requirements are not met, unless prior approval is obtained. All applications must be submitted electronically in a single PDF file in the order listed above.
