PILOT SELECTION BOARD REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

- Cover Letter (One page)
- Resume (One page)
- Official College Transcripts showing Bachelor's Degree earned
 - For final semester graduates interviewing during your final semester, you must submit a letter from your Dean stating that you will graduate at the end of the semester based on current course load along with transcripts.
- Three Letters of Recommendation
 - Military members must have CC and NCOIC letters
- Copy of all Enlisted Performance Reports and/or Officer Performance Reports for current or former military members
- Air Force Officer Qualifying Test Scores (AFOQT 2016 AFRC averages)
 - Pilot 91
 - Navigator 76
 - Verbal 60
 - Quantitative 61
- Pilot Candidate Selection Method Scores (PCSM 2016 AFRC average)
 - **8**1
- Private Pilots Certificate
- FAA Third Class Medical
- Civilian candidates must be less than 30 years old when entering UPT/UNT. Pilots must have vision correctable to 20/20.
- Inform the unit of any prior arrests and moving violations. Include any applicable court documents. These are not job disqualifiers.

Interview boards are held twice a year, in the summer and winter, to select candidates for the Air Force Reserve Command Board (held each November/June). Applicants will not be interviewed if any of the above requirements are not met, unless prior approval is obtained. All applications must be submitted electronically in a <u>single PDF file</u> in the order listed above.
