Flight Engineer Requisites- (1A1XX)

- Must be able to pass a Flying Class III physical
- Have a minimum G-57 ASVAB score
- Prior qualification at the 5 or 7 level in one of the following (*)
 - Air force AFSC: 1A0, 1A2, 1A5, 2A3X1/3, 2A4X1/2, 2A5, 2AX1/3/4/5/6, 2A73X, 2M0
 - Army MOS/s: 67R, 67S, 67T, 67U, 67V, 67Y
 - Navy NEC's: 8235, 8251, 8252, 8261, 8262, 8263

Or

Valid FAA Flight Engineer certificate (with jet or turboprop rating)
Private Pilot's license
Valid FAA airframe and power plant (A&P) license

* Pre-requisite AFSC waiver requests for entry into this career field will be considered on case-by-case basis based on a personal interview and a Math Test given during the interview process.

FLIGHT ENGINEER PACKAGE REQUIREMENTS

- Cover Letter (One page)
- Resume (One page)
- Three Letters of Recommendation
 - Military members must have CC and NCOIC letters
- Copy of all DD214s for current or former military members
- Copy of last three Enlisted Performance Reports (if prior service)
- Copy of ASVAB scores
- Inform the unit of any prior arrests. Include any applicable court documents. This is not a job disqualifier.

Interviews will be given by appointment only. Applicants will not be interviewed if any of the above requirements are not met, unless prior approval is obtained. All applications must be submitted electronically in a single file PDF in the order listed above.
